

# IMPORTING GRAPHS AND IMAGES WITH GRAPHS INTO RICOH DIGITAL CAMERAS

## PROCEDURES WITH MACINTOSH AND CLARISWORKS 4.0

- Open *ClarisWorks 4.0*, and select the **ClarisWorks Assistants Presentation**.
- Go to **File New** to select a **Spreadsheet** document.
- Enter in the needed information for the graph. Once this has been completed, click on **Options Make Chart**.
- Now select what type of chart you need, then click on **OK**.
- After the chart has been made, click on it and go to **Edit Copy**.
- This will copy it onto the clipboard. From there, open up *Ricoh PhotoStudio 2.0*.
- Within *Ricoh PhotoStudio*, **File New**, and change the **Width** to 768, the **Height** to 576, and turn off Keep Proportions by clicking on the checked box. Click on **OK**.
- Now go to **Edit Paste**. This will bring the images in from the clipboard.
- To save the image as a **Ricoh DSC \*.J6I**, the format needed to transfer the image to the camera, click on **File Save As**, and save it as the **Ricoh DSC \*.J6I** format.
- Open *PhotoStudio Browser*. Open up an existing catalog or create a new one. Save this catalog if it is new.
- Go to **File Add**, and select the image that you wish to add. This will bring it into a thumbnail version within the *PhotoStudio Browser*.
- Once it has been added, click on that thumbnail so that it is active. Now go to **File Save to Ricoh Camera**.
